

Art and Poetry Show Call to Artists/Writers



Calling all friends of mental health: Vermont artists & writers are invited to submit either 2D or 3D artwork or written pieces

for a celebration of creativity in mental health awareness

Location: White River Craft Center, 50 Randolph Ave., Randolph, VT

September 23 through November 20, 2022

Theme:

"STRONGER TOGETHER": Celebrating Creativity in Mental Health, Wellness, and Recovery

~ Entry Requirements:

Must be a Vermont resident (first preference will be given to artists/writers in the White River Valley & the Upper Valley).

~ **Artwork (visual or written word) must be hang-ready**: secured in a frame or a sturdy supportive background with a hanging device (D-Rings recommended, sawtooth hangers not recommended). We are unable to accept work that is not prepared to be safely displayed. We are not able to accept pieces that need to be suspended from the ceiling such as mobiles.

artists/writers must agree to leave pieces	displayed for the entire time frame	(initials)	

- ~ Photo images of up to 3 pieces of artwork may be submitted either electronically/digitally, or a photo may be submitted by snail mail.
 - Artists/writers must explain how their piece fits into the "STRONGER TOGETHER" theme of the show. Creativity in interpretation of the theme is welcomed and appreciated.
 - Work will be displayed at the risk of the artist/writer. Clara Martin Center and White River Craft Center are not responsible for damage, loss, or pieces not hung in the way that an artist/writer might expect. Every attempt will be made to hang appropriately but the artist must accept the manner of displaying that is implemented.

 - There may be restrictions to very large sizes.

Artist's/Writer's Application: Artists/Writers must fill out an application (on reverse side) including contact information, a description of the art piece, how it fits into the show's theme, medium used, and sale price if wishing to sell. (There will be a 15% commission to the White River Craft Center.)

Timeline:

- Submission Date: Submit up to 3 pieces of artwork/written pieces for review by selection panel by August 19, 2022.
- Selection Notification: notification will be given to artists and writers by August 26, 2022.
- **Drop off Date**: drop off your work at White River Craft Center:
 - Either: September 15th from 10:30am-1:30pm OR September 16th from 2:30pm-5:30pm.
- Show Dates: On display from September 23, 2022 until November 20, 2022.
- Closing Date: Final day of show will be Sunday November 20, 2022 12:00 pm 2:00pm.
- Pick-up Dates: November 20, 2022 from 2:00pm 4:00pm OR November 21, 2022 from 11:00 am 2:00pm
