In today's healthcare environment, Clara Martin Center has positioned itself to be competitive in the health care marketplace, to be accountable for the care we deliver, and has demonstrated a commitment to providing local services. We have incorporated the Result's Based Accountability model into our daily practice, which was embraced by the State Administration and the Vermont State Legislature in 2014. We are 2 years into the successful implementation of our electronic health record. This expansion of technology has allowed us to be more efficient with our care delivery system and we are able to analyze our data and compete in today's health care reform efforts.

Our high quality services are a testament to our most important resource, our staff. Staff continue to be trained on evidence based practices to ensure our services are the most effective for our clients and the communities which we serve.

Our annual client satisfaction survey continues to demonstrate that we are meeting our mission. In 2013 and 2014, almost 600 clients and family members responded to our survey. 98% reported that Clara Martin Center treats them with dignity and respect and 95% reported that they made progress with their treatment goals/received the help they needed. In addition, reports indicate that we have one of the highest penetration rates in the State, Almost 600 clients or family members responded to our 2013 and 2014 client satisfaction survey.
